- They help it to sneak up on its prey as it moves through the long and tall grasses.

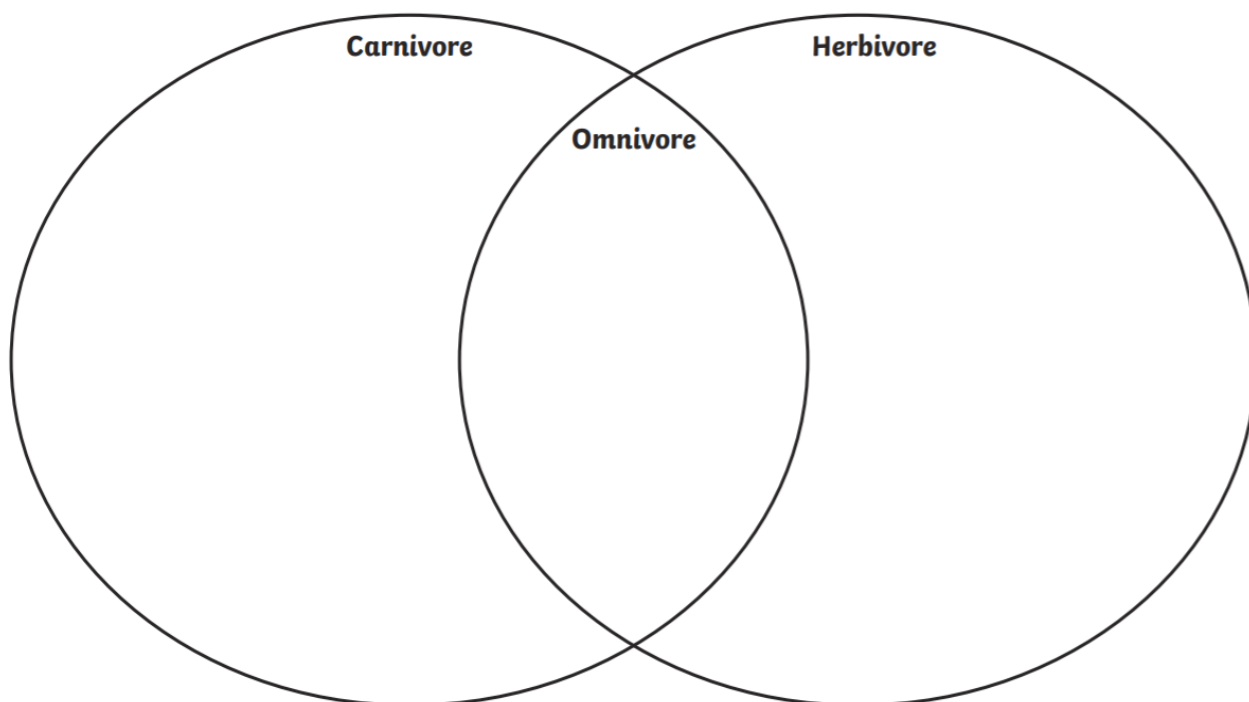
