

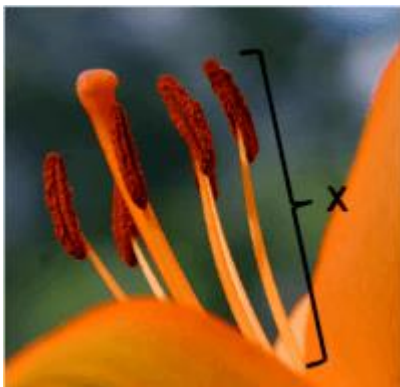

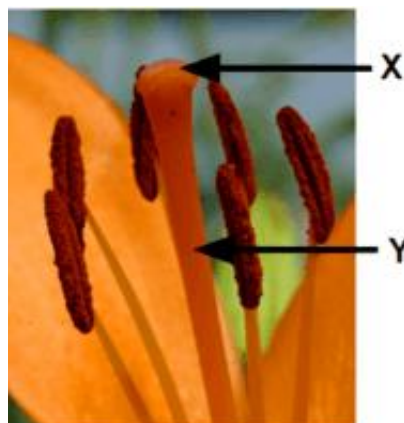
Q2. What is the name of the structure labelled X in the diagram?

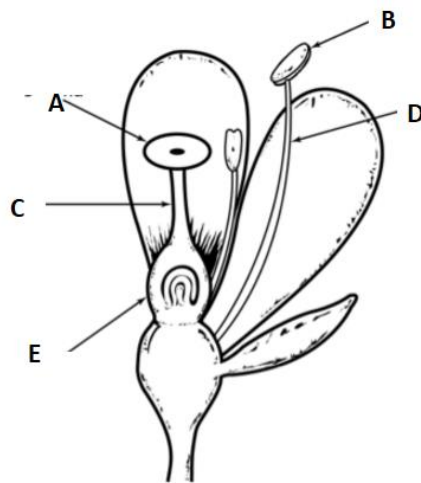
