Polygon – A 2D shape where all are straight sides.


Quadrilateral – Quad – four lateral – sides

Chord – A line segment whose start and endpoint are on the boundary of circle and it passes through the circle.

Symmetry – Shapes or figures having two halves that match each other exactly in size, shape..etc
