Plan (1951-56): Raise agricultural production

Plan (1956 - 61): Rapid Industrialisation

Plan (1961 - 66): Self - Sufficiency in foodgrains and expand basic industries

Plan (1969-74) : Self - Reliance

Plan (1974 - 79) Self - Reliance and removal of poverty

Plan (1980 - 85) Self - Reliance

Plan (1985 - 90) Growth of foodgrain production, development of infrastructural services.

Plan (1992 - 97) Self - Sufficiency in food, generating export surplus and strengthening infrastructure

Plan (1997 - 2002) Improve quality of life

Plan (2002 - 2007) Improve quality of life

Plan (2007 - 2012) Sustainable and inclusive growth

Plan (2012-2017) Inclusive growth.
