Why Safety Rules Matter

Protect Everyone

Safety rules keep us and others safe every day from accidents and harm.

Stay Healthy

Knowing what to do helps us avoid accidents and stay healthy and happy.

Safety Rules at Home



Ask First

Always ask an adult before using sharp knives, hot stoves, or electrical appliances.



Keep Floors Safe

Keep floors clean and dry to avoid slips and falls. Put toys away after playing!



Emergency Numbers

Know how to call for help in an emergency. Remember 911 or your local emergency number.



Stranger Safety

Never open the door to strangers. Always check with an adult first.

Basic First Aid Everyone Should Know

O1

Clean Small Cuts

If someone gets a small cut, gently clean it with water and cover it with a clean bandage.

O2

Treat Bumps

For bumps and bruises, use ice wrapped in a soft cloth to reduce swelling and pain.

O3

Get Adult Help

Always tell an adult immediately if someone is hurt, no matter how small the injury seems.

O4

Stay Calm

Remember to stay calm and help safely. Panicking doesn't help anyone!





Safety Rules at School

Walk Don't Run

Walk calmly in hallways and playgrounds. Running can cause accidents and injuries to yourself and others.

Listen to Teachers

Always listen to teachers and follow school safety signs. They know how to keep you safe!

Playground Safety

Use playground equipment properly. Take turns, hold on tight, and follow playground rules.

Stay Together

Always stay with your group during field trips or outside activities. Never wander off alone.

Understanding Traffic Signals



Red Light

Stop and wait safely. Never move when the light is red.

Yellow Light

Get ready to stop. The light will turn red soon.

Green Light

Go carefully after looking both ways first.



Pedestrian Signals: Walk only when you see the white "WALK" person symbol. Wait when you see the red hand!

Common Traffic Signs You Should Know



Stop Sign

Cars and people must stop completely at this red octagonal sign. Look all ways before continuing.



Pedestrian Crossing

This shows a safe place to cross the street. Always use these marked crosswalks.



School Zone

Cars must slow down and watch carefully for children in these special school areas.



No Walking Sign

Areas where pedestrians and bikes are not allowed for safety reasons.



How to Cross the Road Safely



Stop at the Curb

Always stop at the curb or edge of the sidewalk. Never step into the street without stopping first.



Look All Ways

Look left, right, then left again before crossing. Keep looking while you cross!



Use Crosswalks

Cross only at crosswalks or intersections with traffic signals. These are the safest places.



Hold Hands

Always hold an adult's hand when crossing busy streets. Stay close and walk together.
