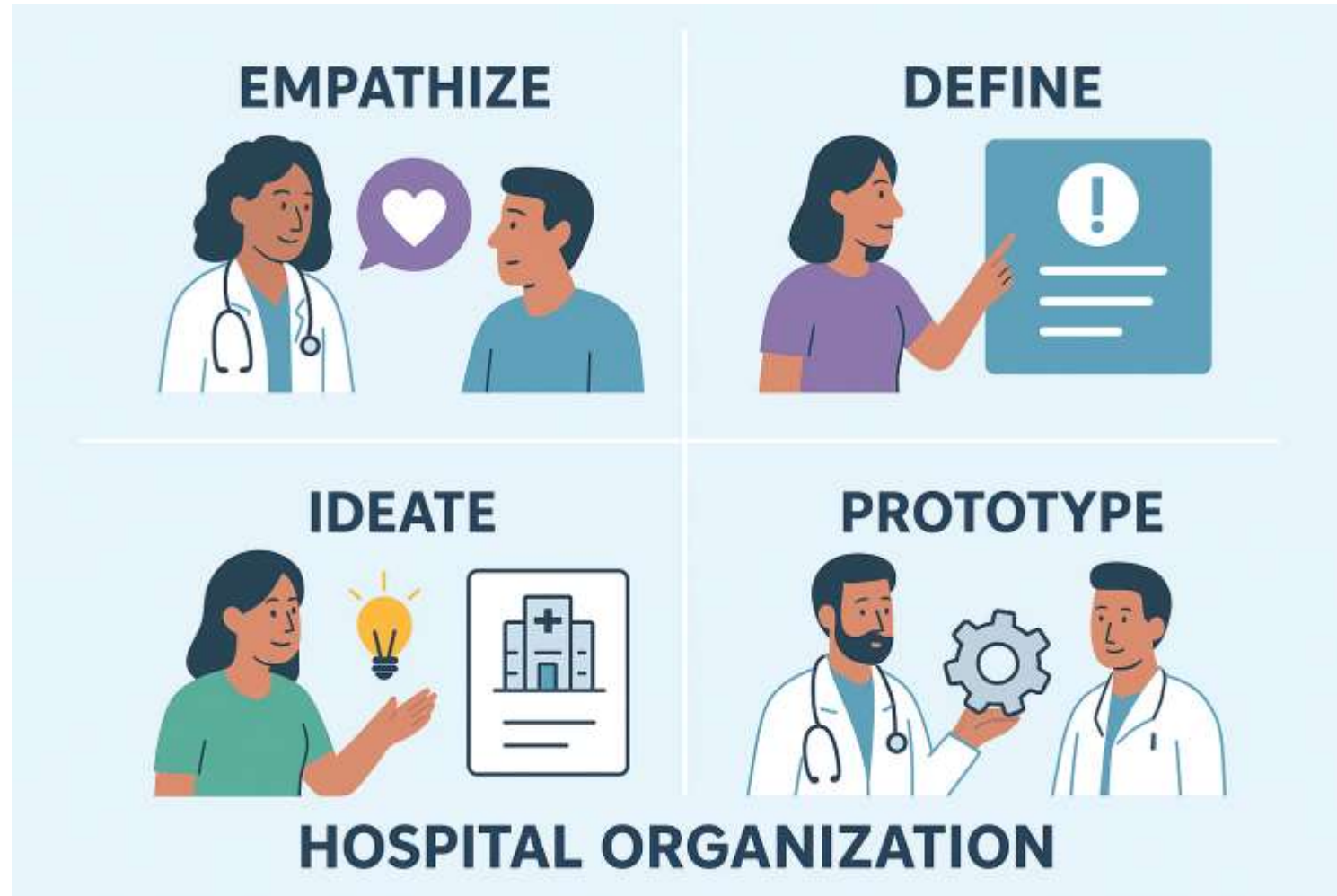

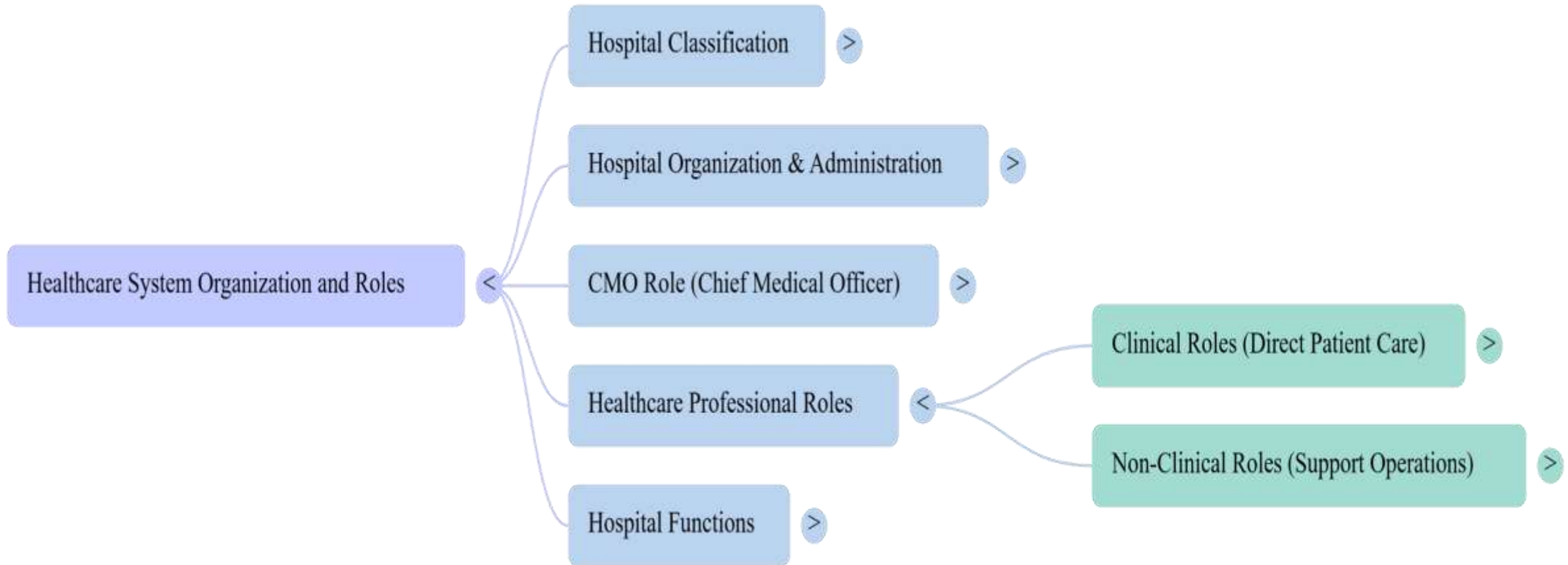

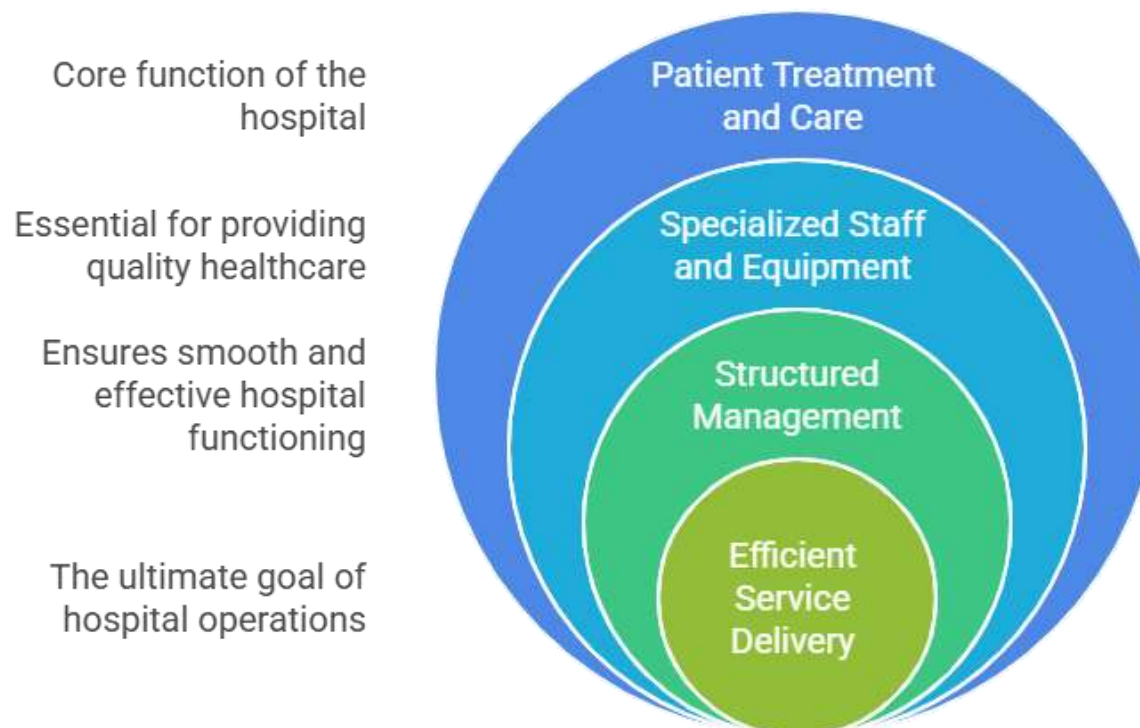

Emphasizes the need for organized leadership and administration.

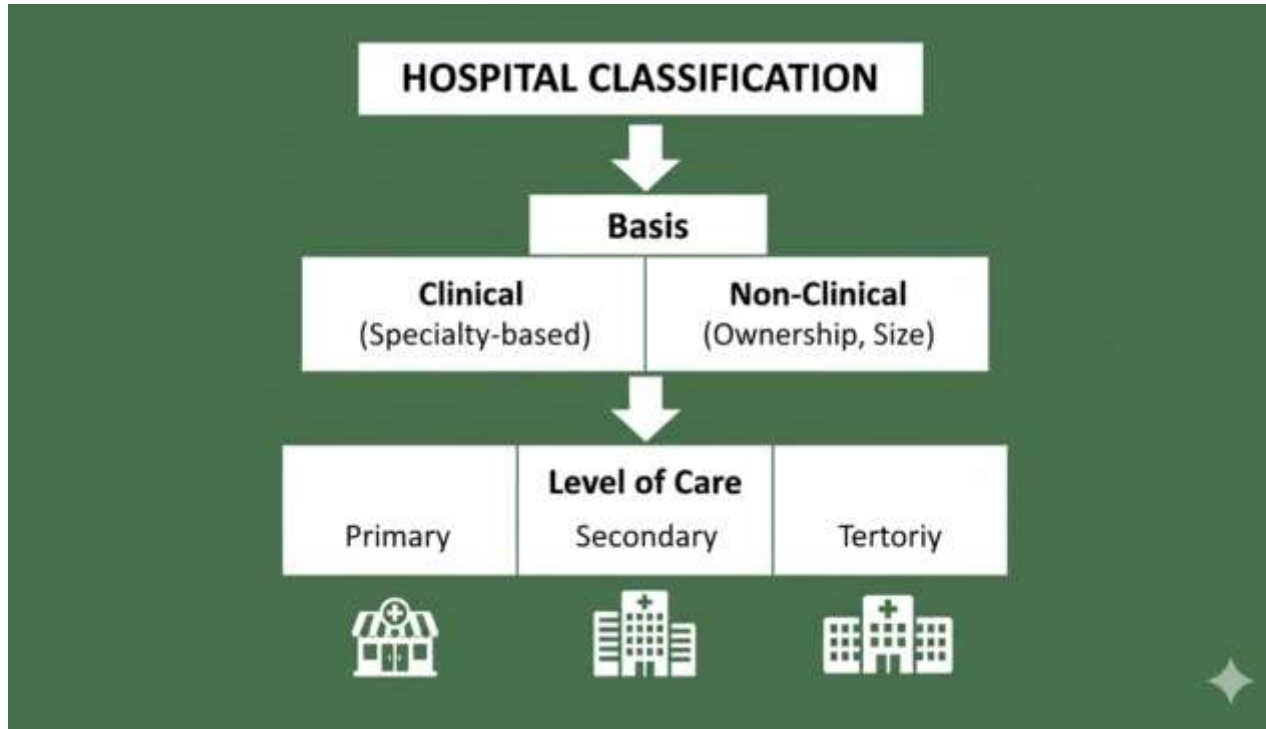

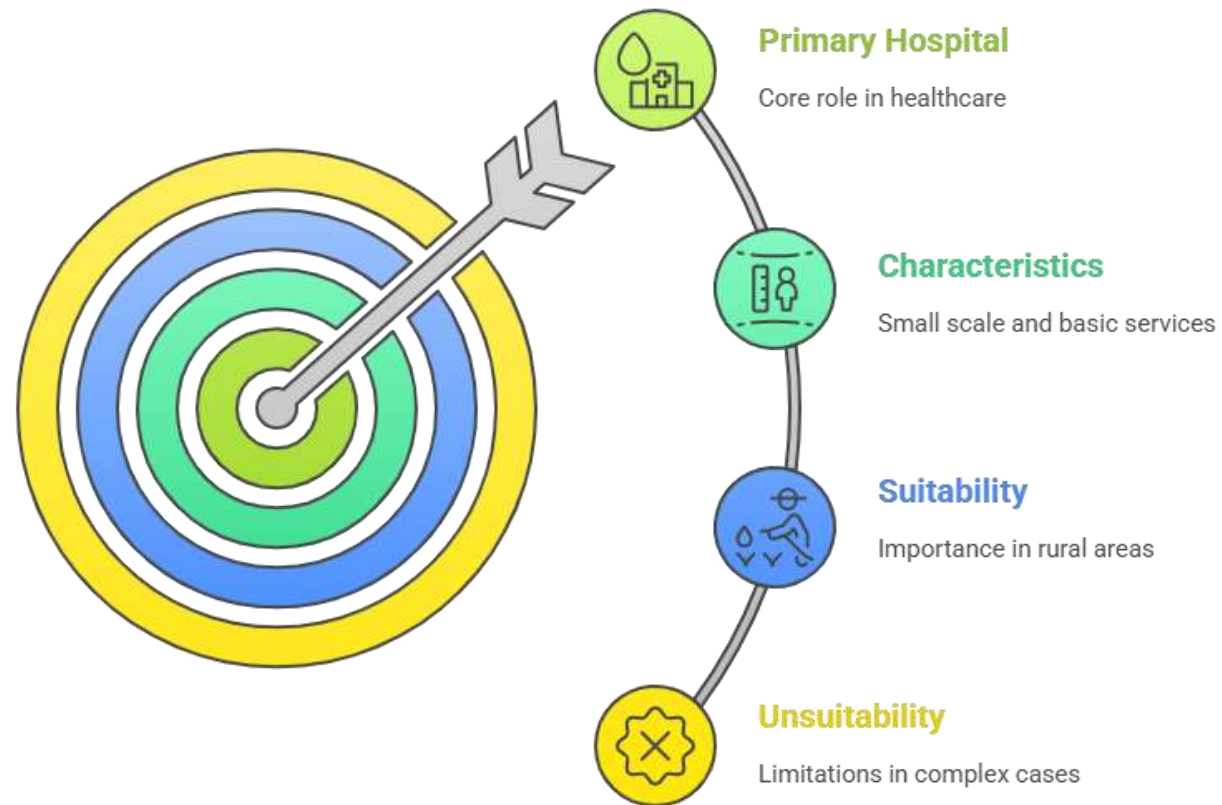

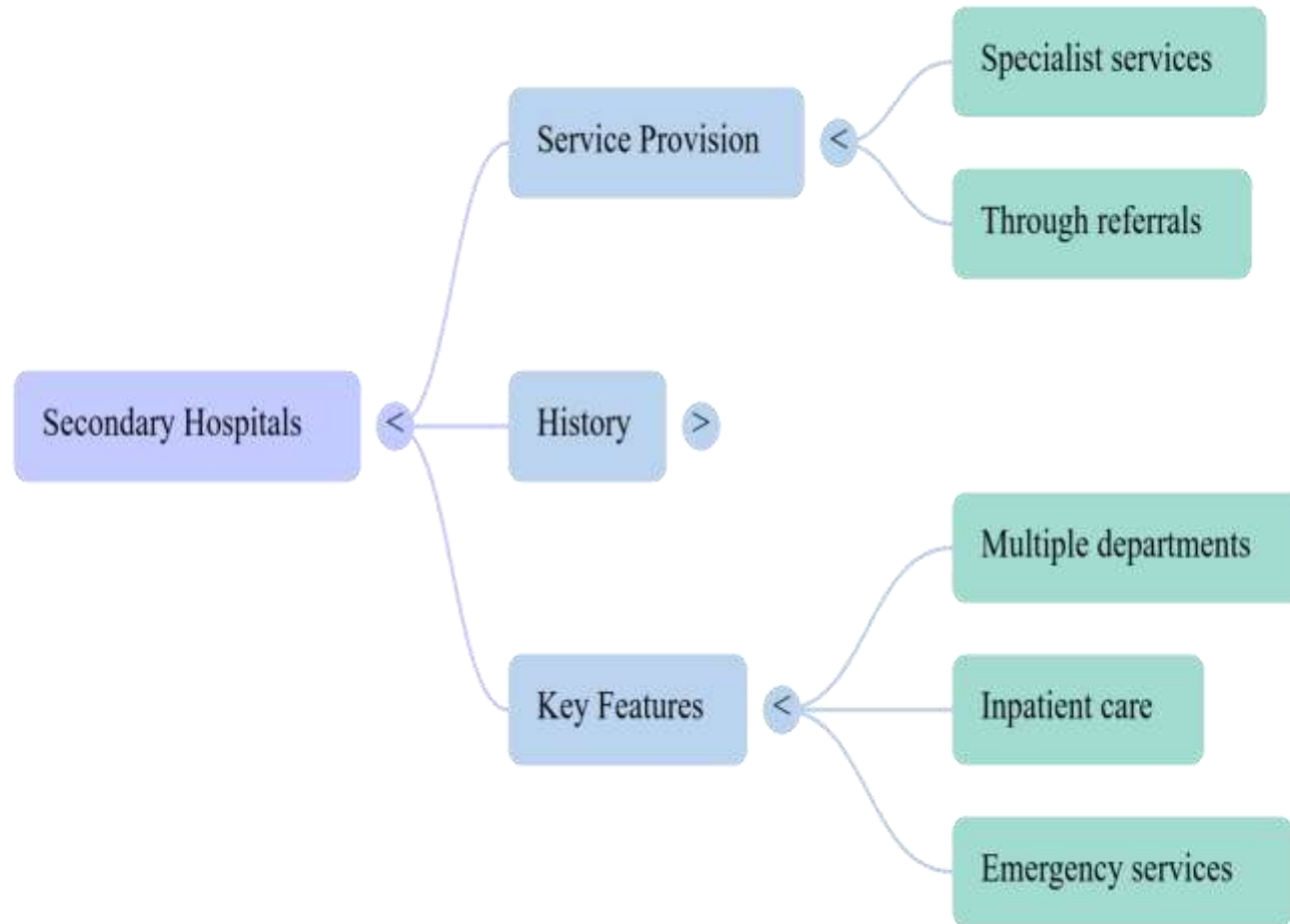

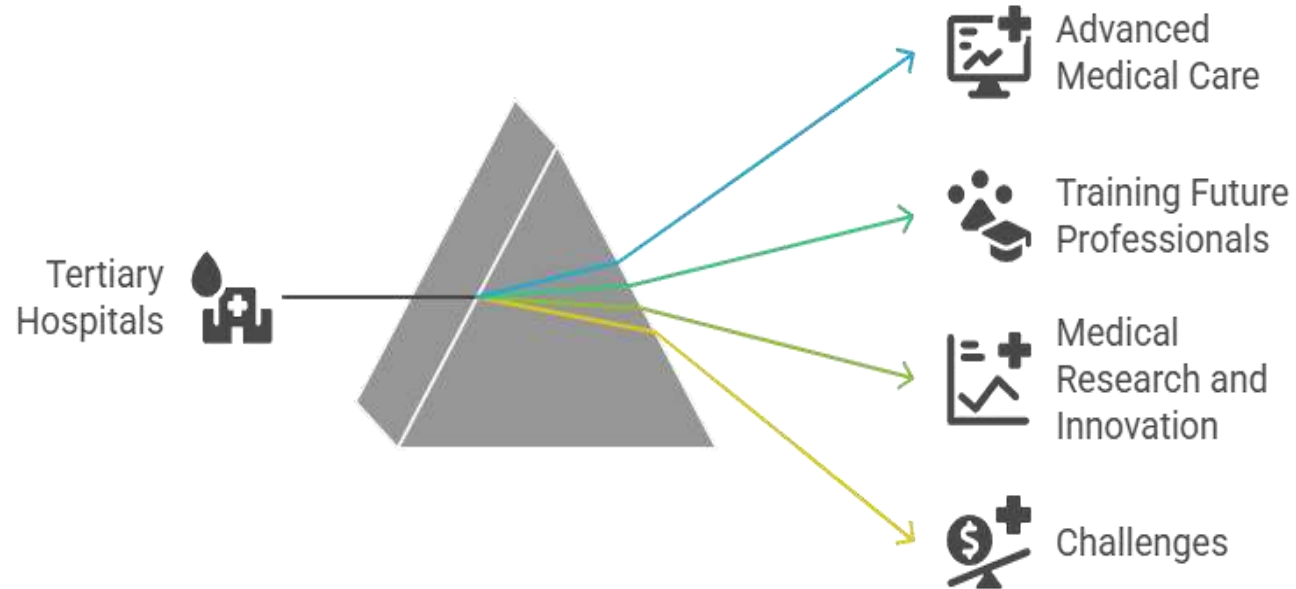

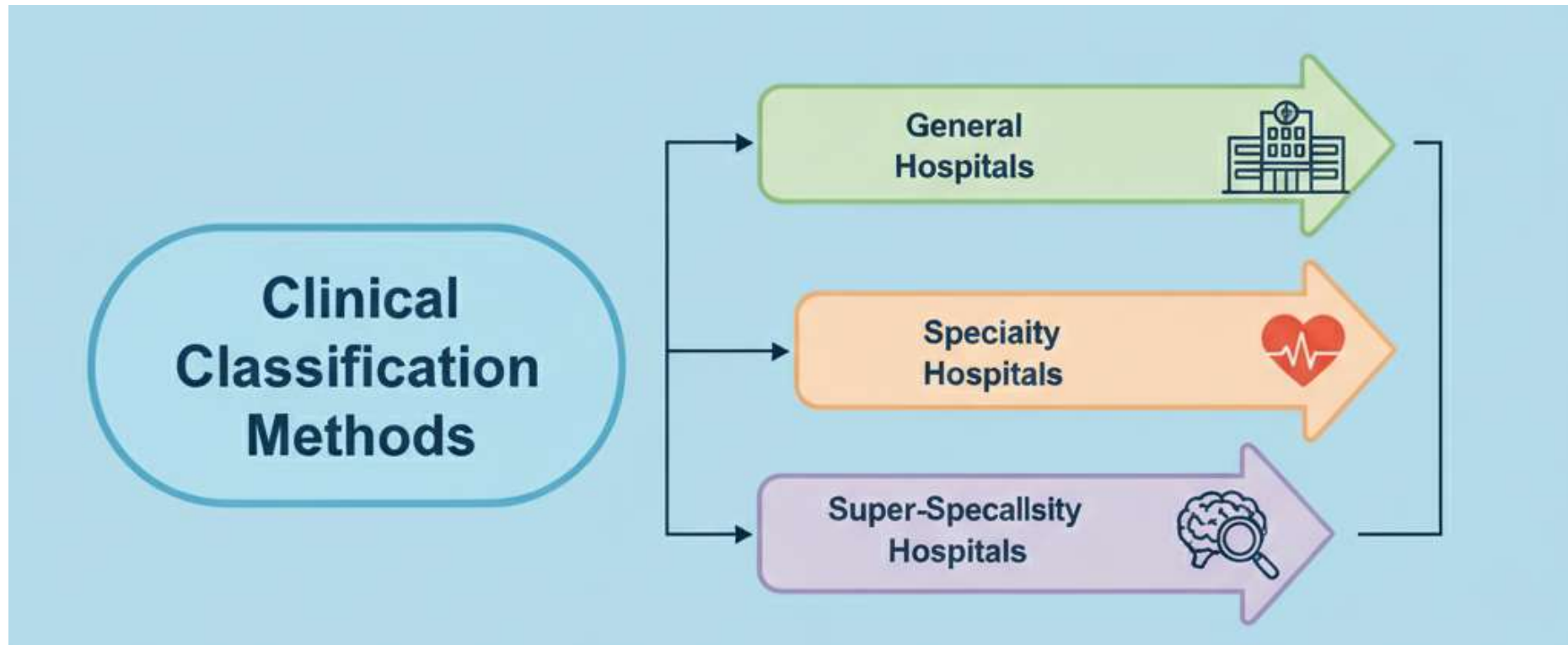

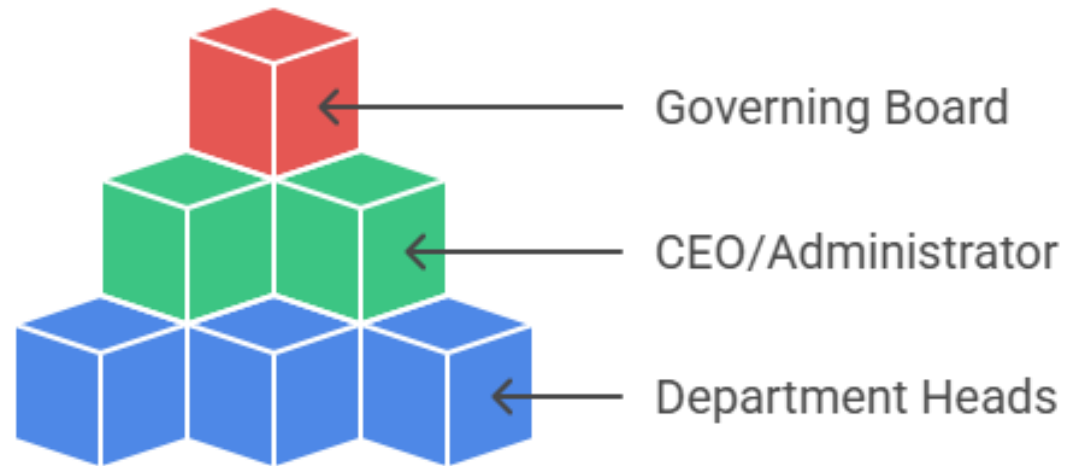

- Patient monitoring and care.

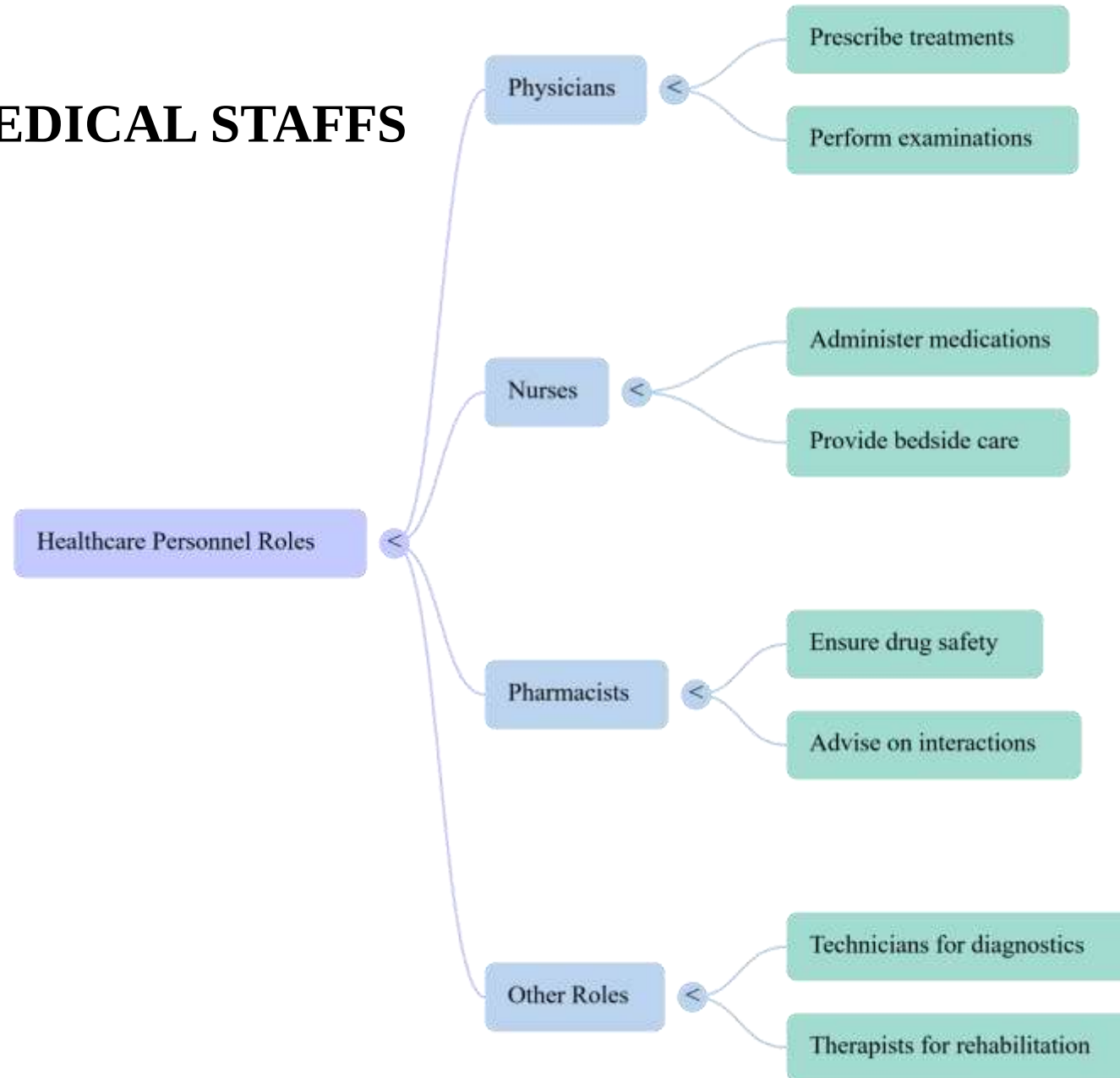

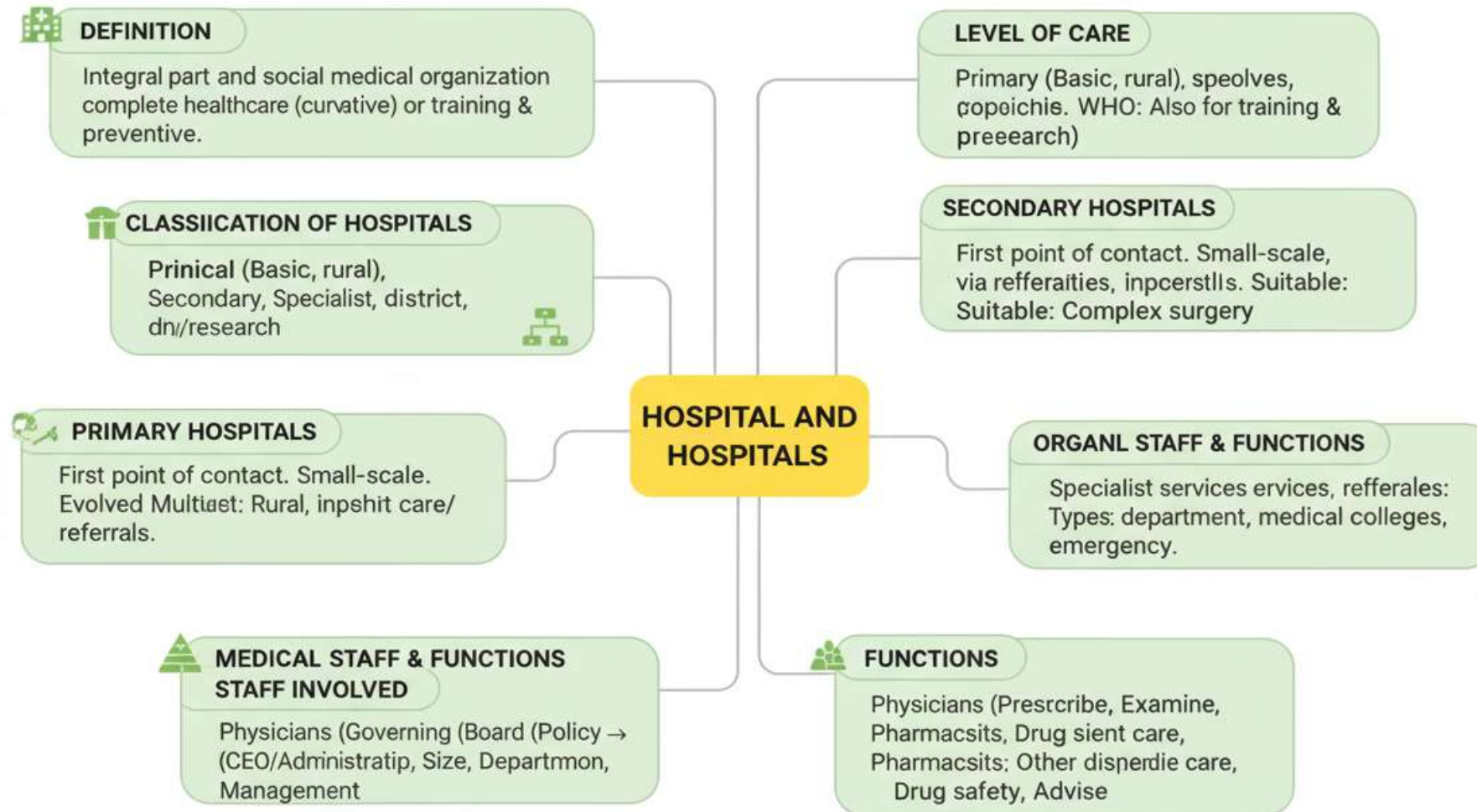

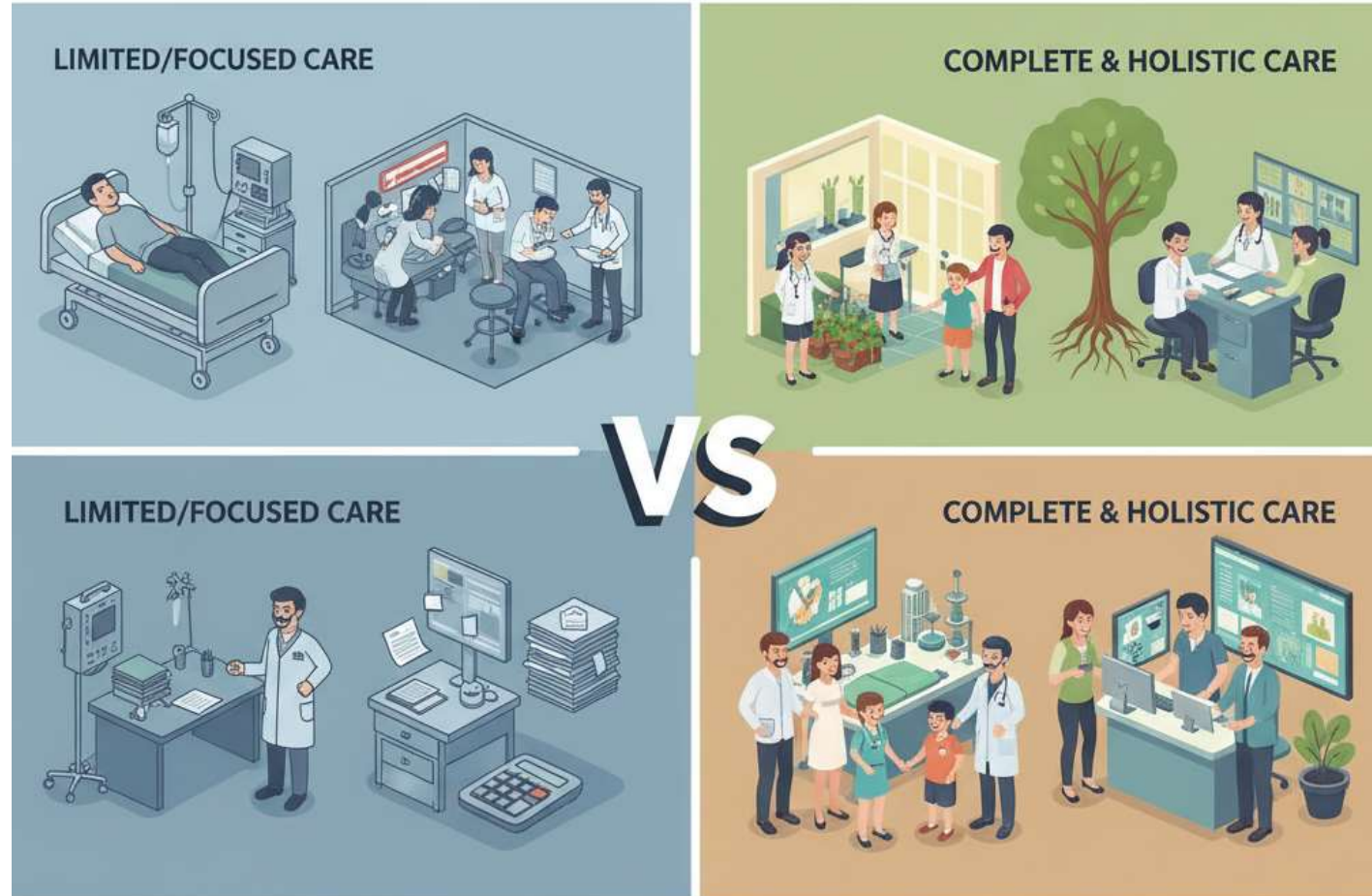
