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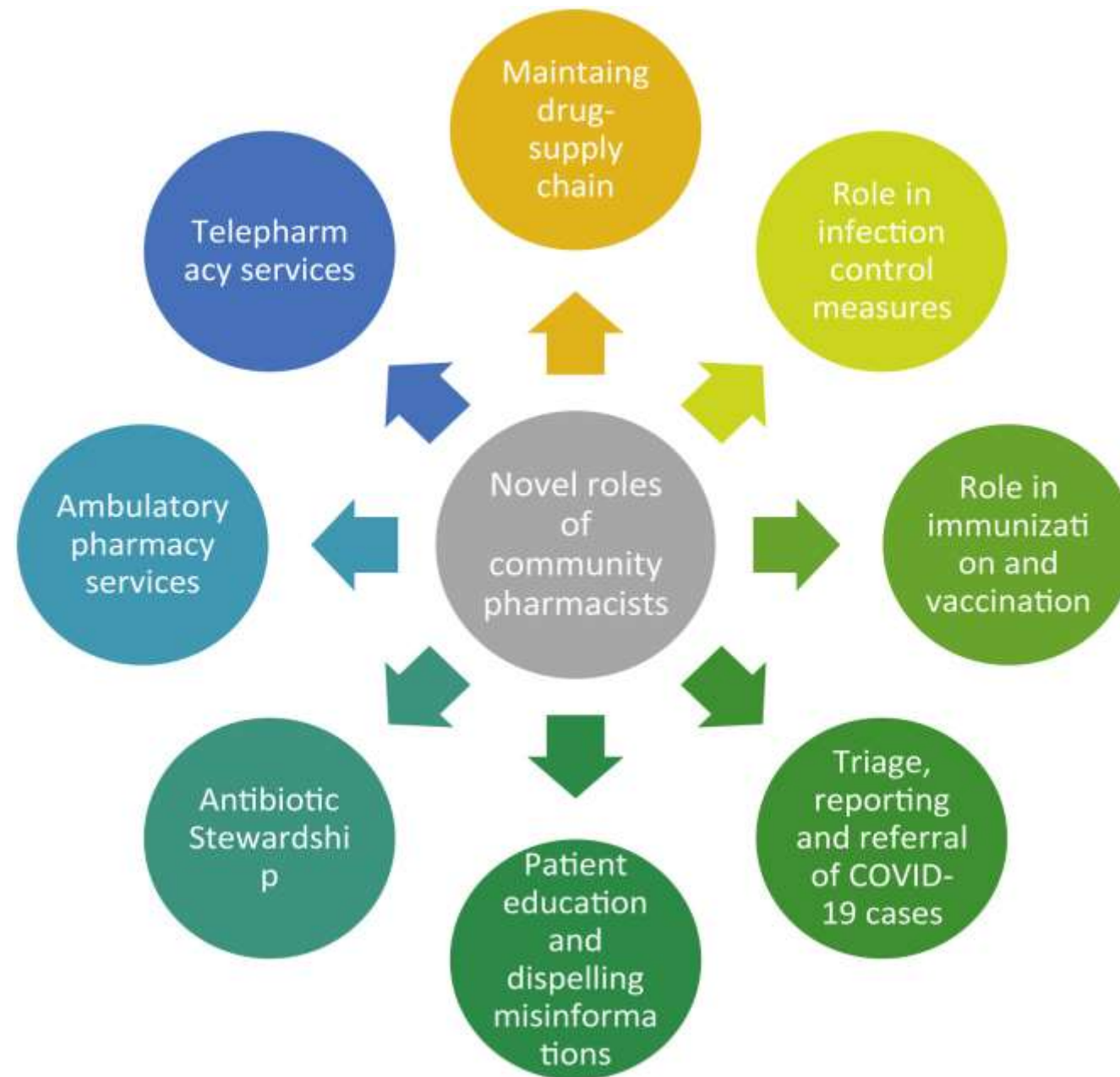

- Provides advice on prescriptions
- Offers over-the-counter medications

- Diagnoses health conditions
- Prescribes medications

12 things your pharmacist can help with

6 Healthy living advice

Free advice on healthy eating and a wide range of issues, including heart health, smoking, alcohol and children's diet and weight management

7 Medicines use reviews including respiratory advice

You can talk to your community pharmacist to ensure you are taking the right medicines you need and that you are taking your prescribed medication as you should do every day. They can also advise on how to reduce and manage side effects and could suggest alternative products to the doctor

5 Delivery to your door

If you are older or unable to collect your prescriptions many community pharmacists can arrange to deliver medication right to your doorstep promptly and reliably

4 Baby care

Community pharmacists are trained to give advice on feeding, nutrition and baby care

3 Flu protection

Many community pharmacies now offer the NHS free flu vaccination to adults at risk of flu including pregnant women, carers, people aged 65 and over, frontline patient facing staff in health organisations and those with long-term health conditions

2 Instant solution

Minor illnesses, like coughs and colds, hay fever, rashes and aches and pains can be assessed by a community pharmacist and treatment recommended on the spot

1 Save time

Community pharmacists are clinically trained and available at convenient, longer hours with no appointment

8 Sexual health for young people

Some community pharmacies in Richmond are part of the Richmond borough public health led sexual health services for young people. The service provides emergency contraception, chlamydia screening and treatment as well as condom distribution

9 Safe disposal of medication

You can return unwanted medicines and community pharmacists will dispose of them safely

10 Stop smoking advice and support

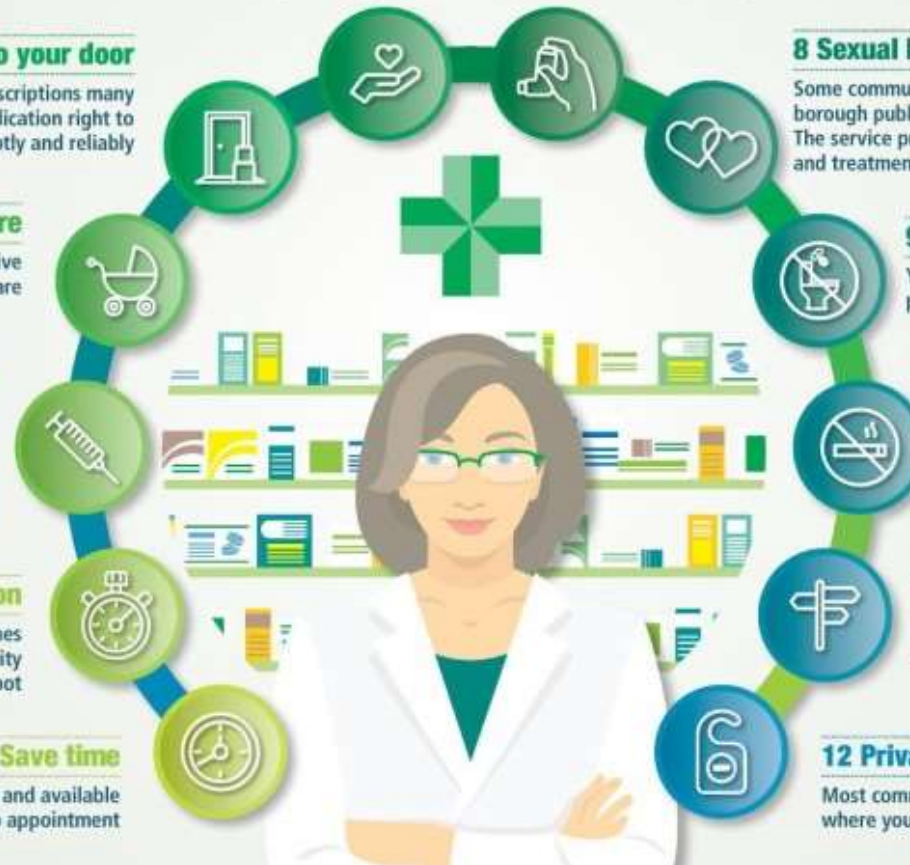
Free advice and support to help you cut down and quit for good

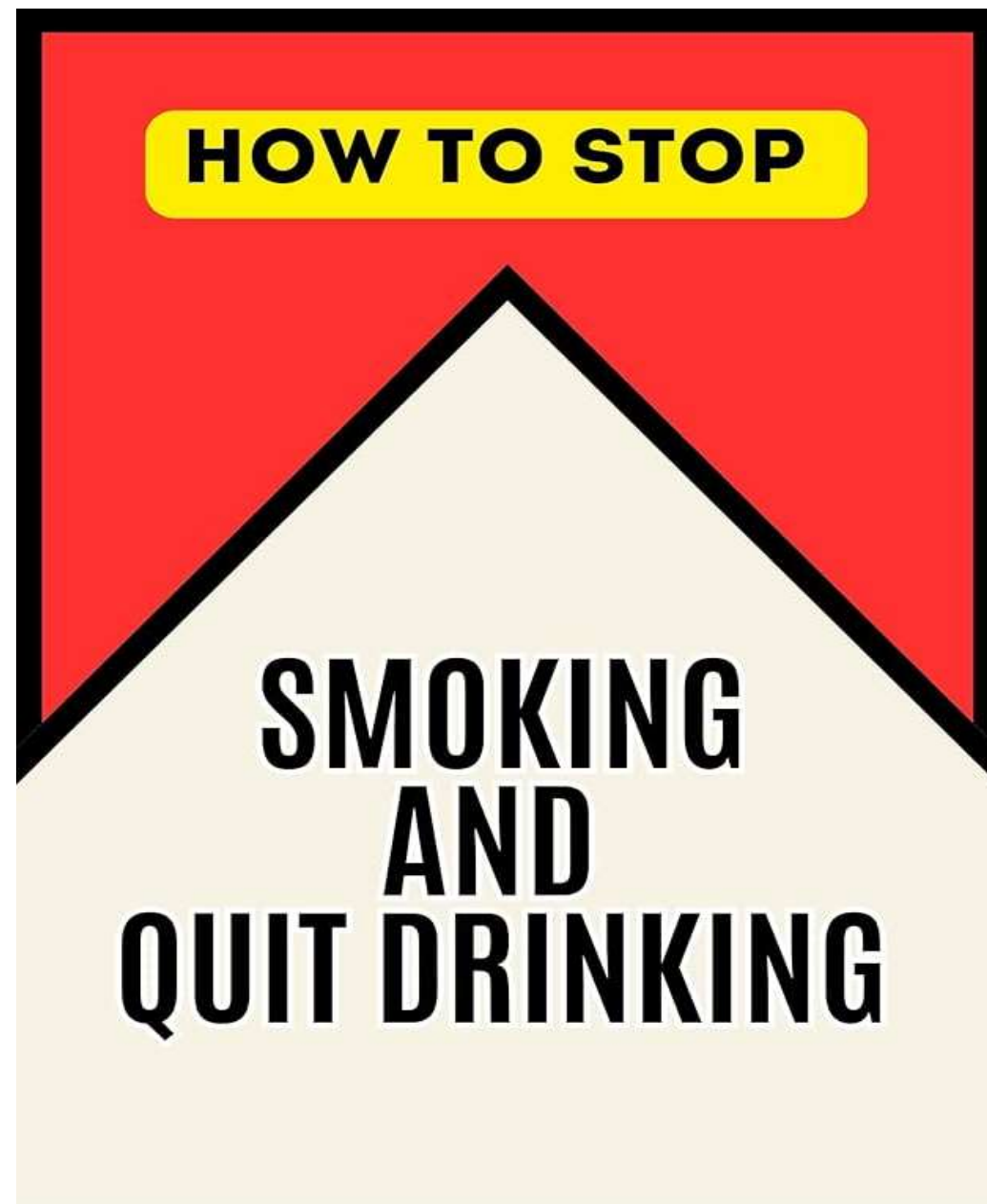
11 Advice on local support services

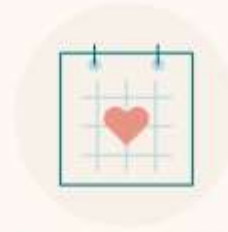
