Fake or misrepresented medications containing incorrect ingredients, insufficient active ingredients, or harmful substances.

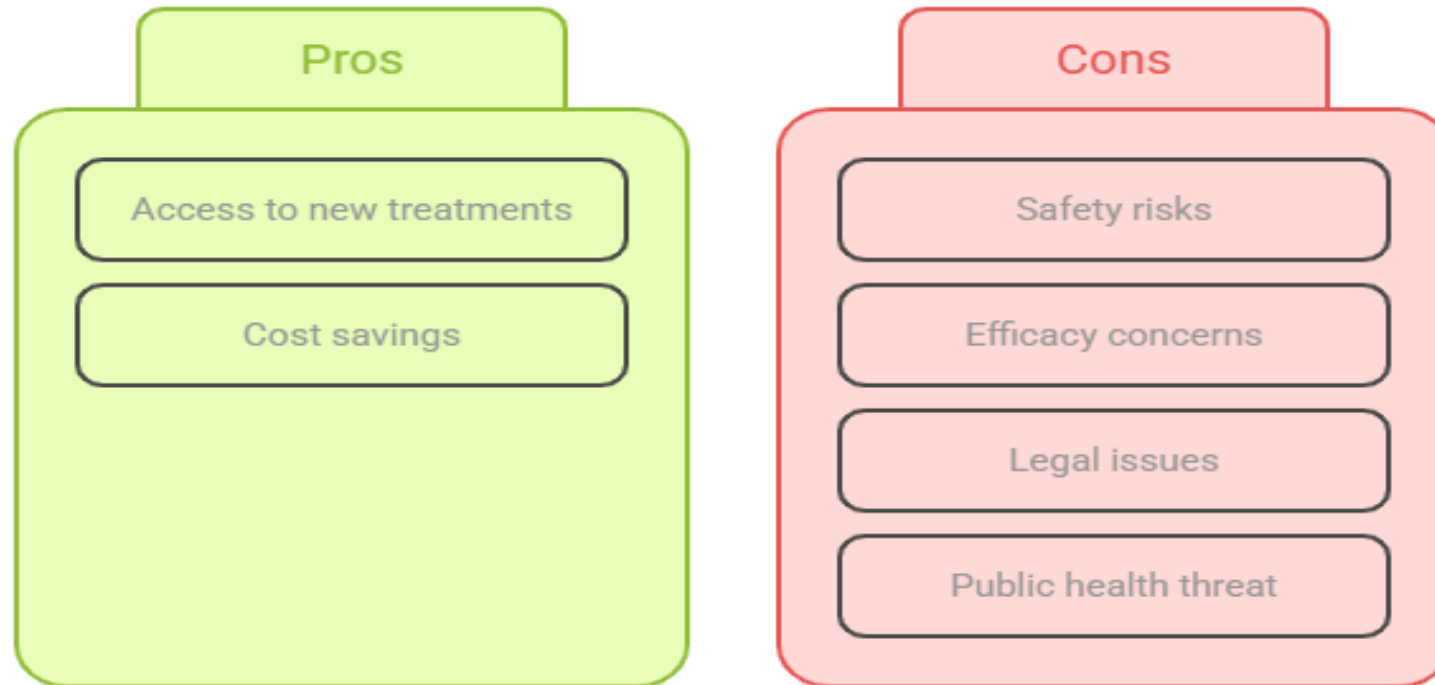
Why are they prohibited?

Importing them is illegal and can have severe health consequences.



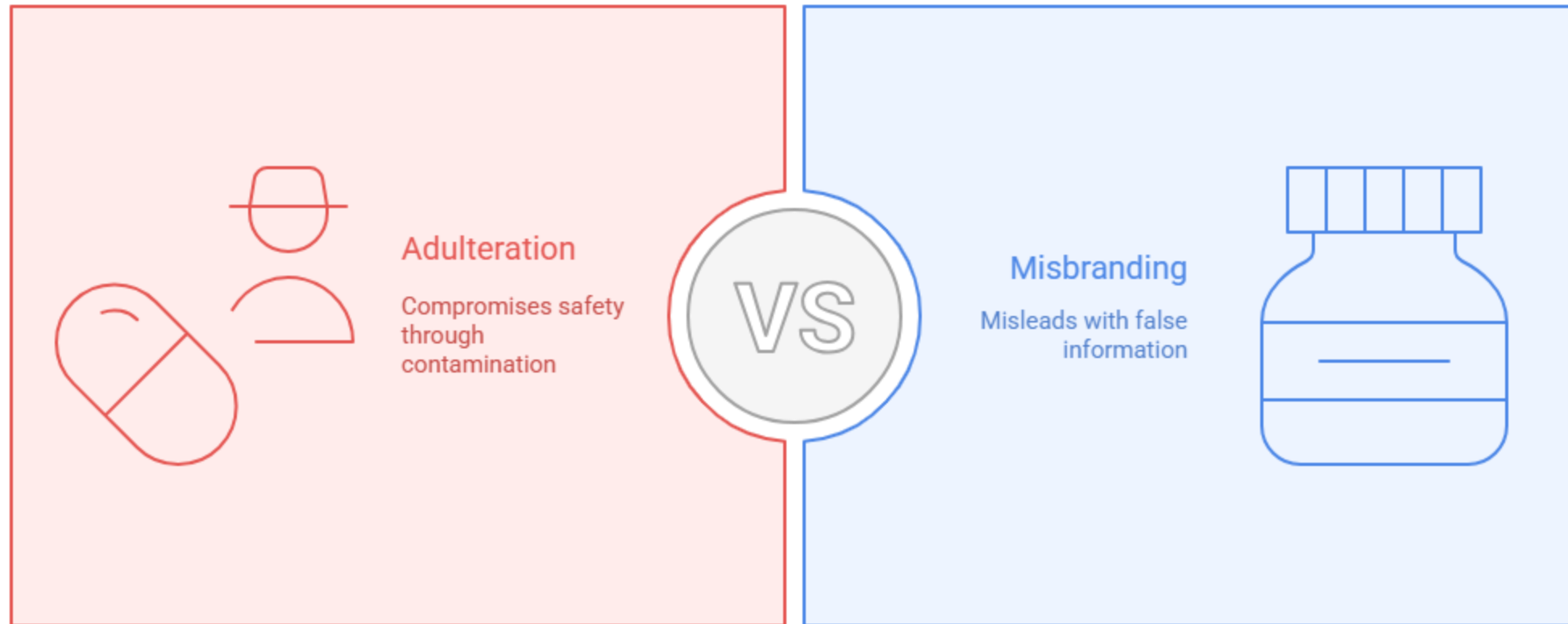

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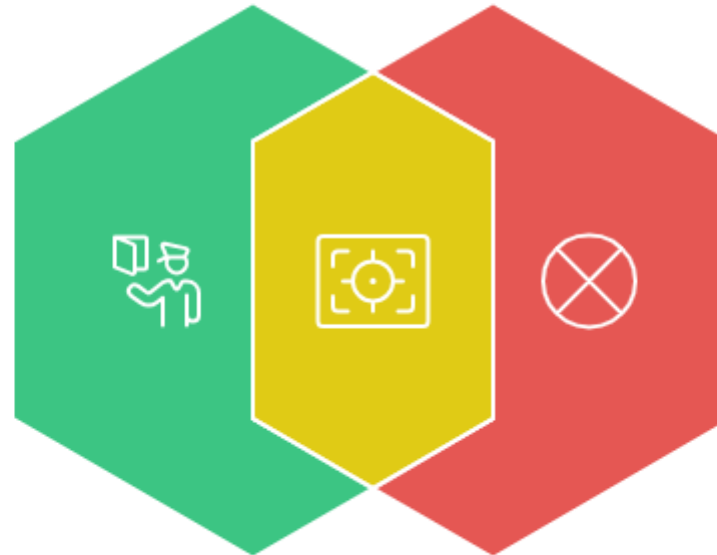
Legal vs. Illegal Import of Controlled Substances

With permits and compliance

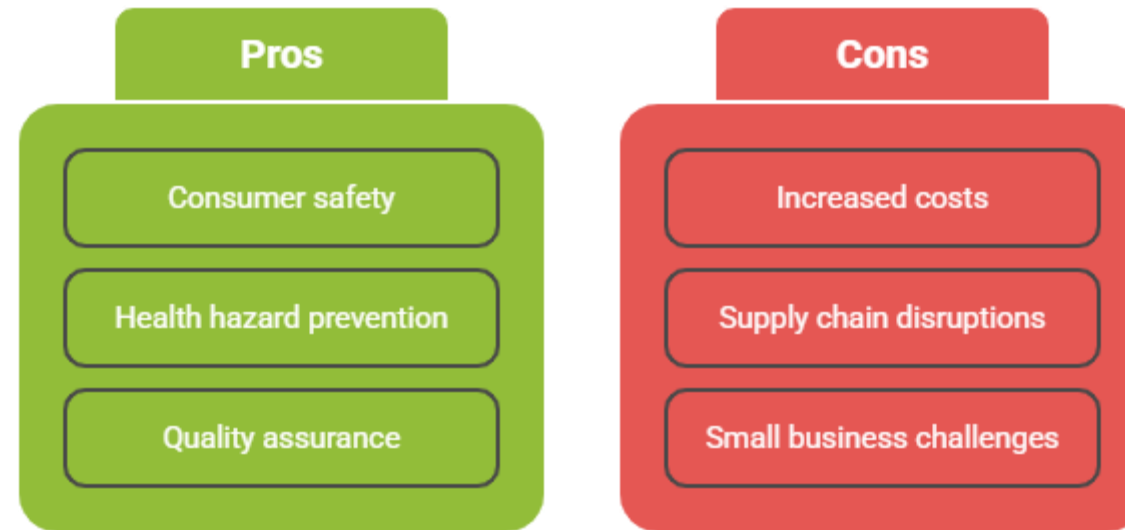


Prohibited Import

Without proper authorization

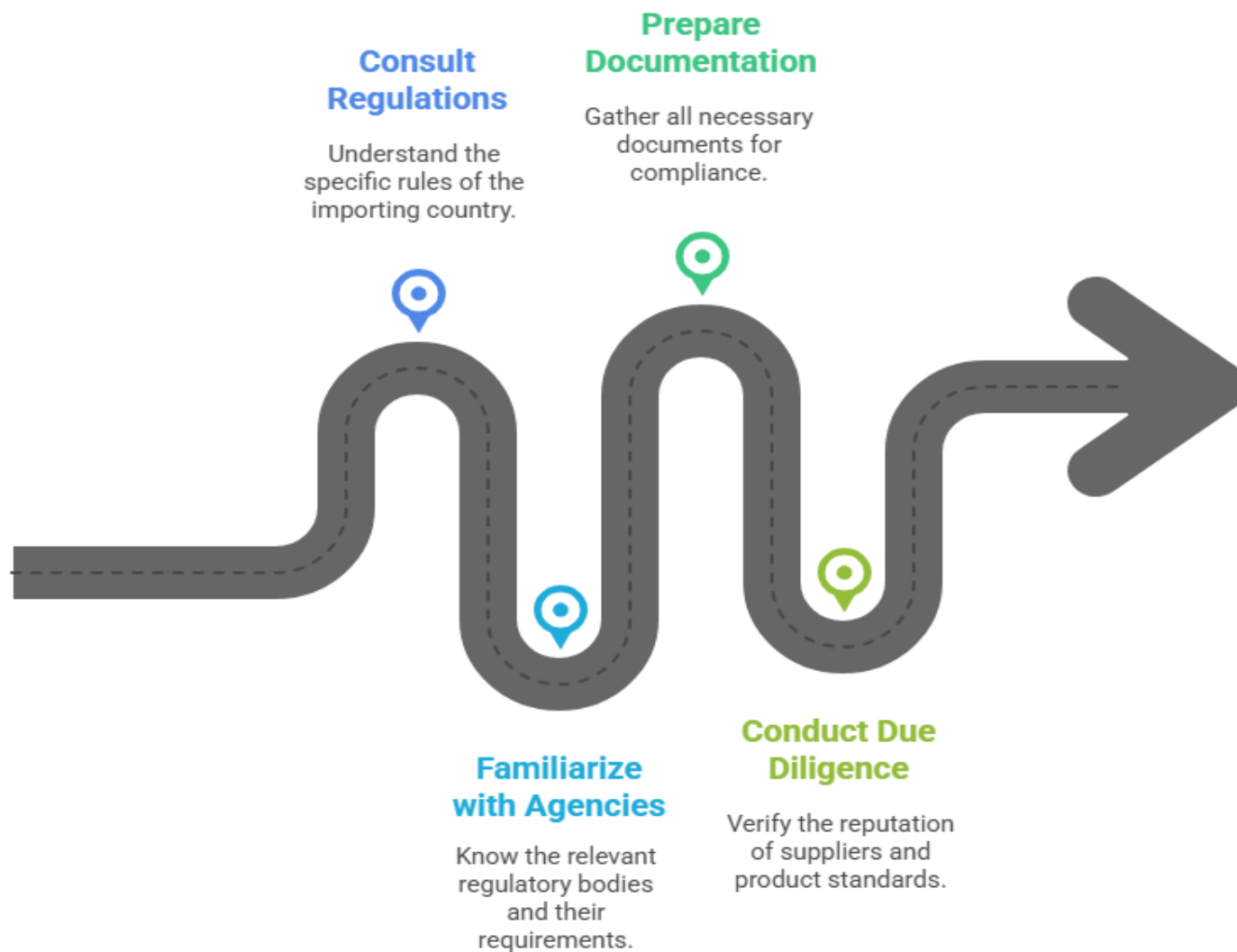
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Cosmetic production standards



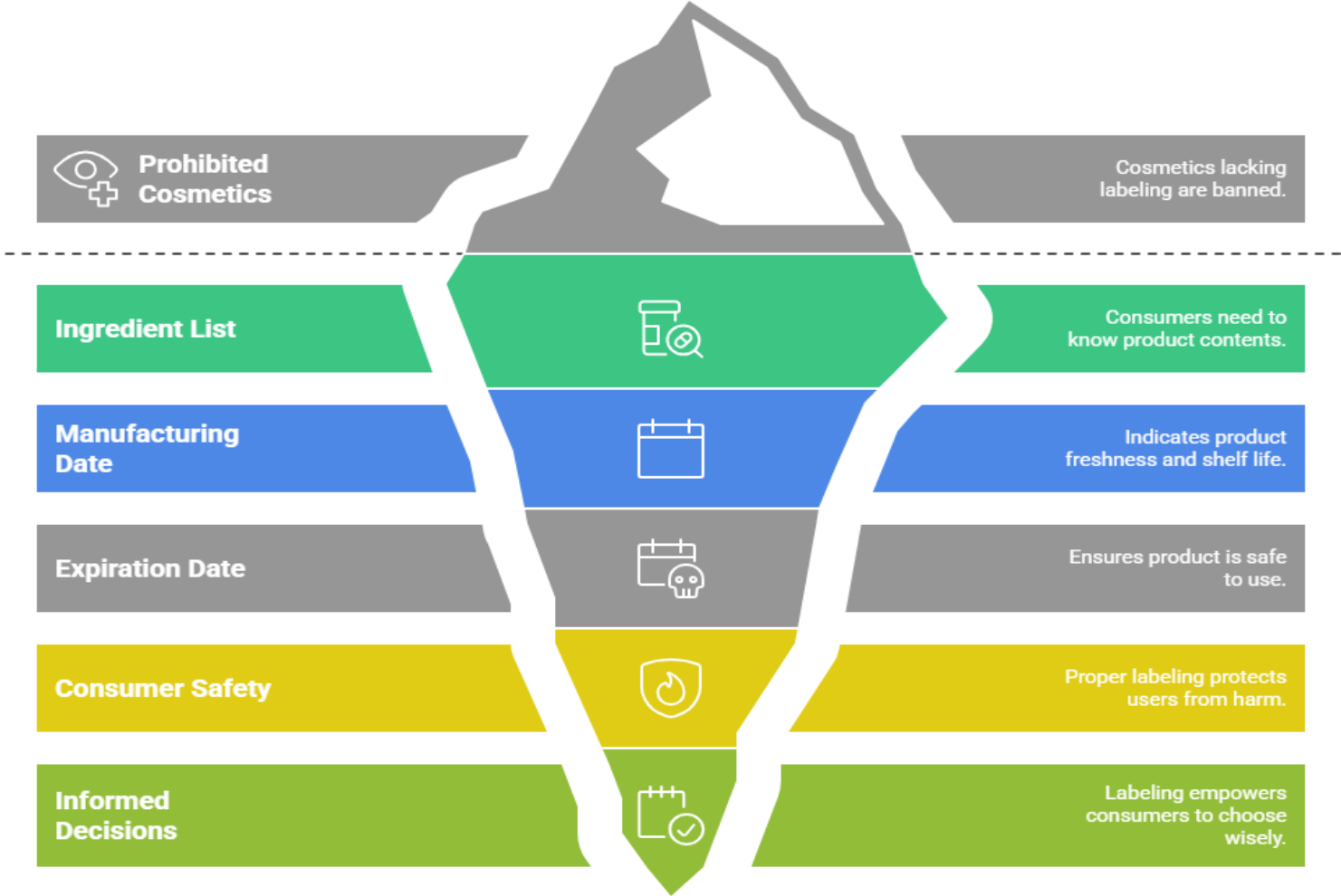
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Ensuring Compliance in Drug and Cosmetic Imports



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Cosmetic Safety Hinges on Labeling.

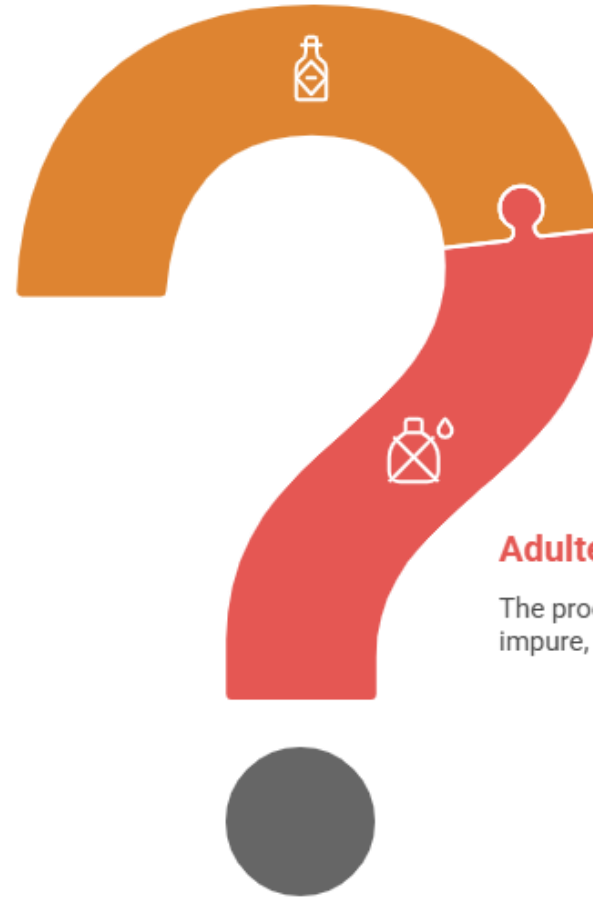


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Should the cosmetic product be prohibited?

The product label is false or misleading, deceiving consumers.

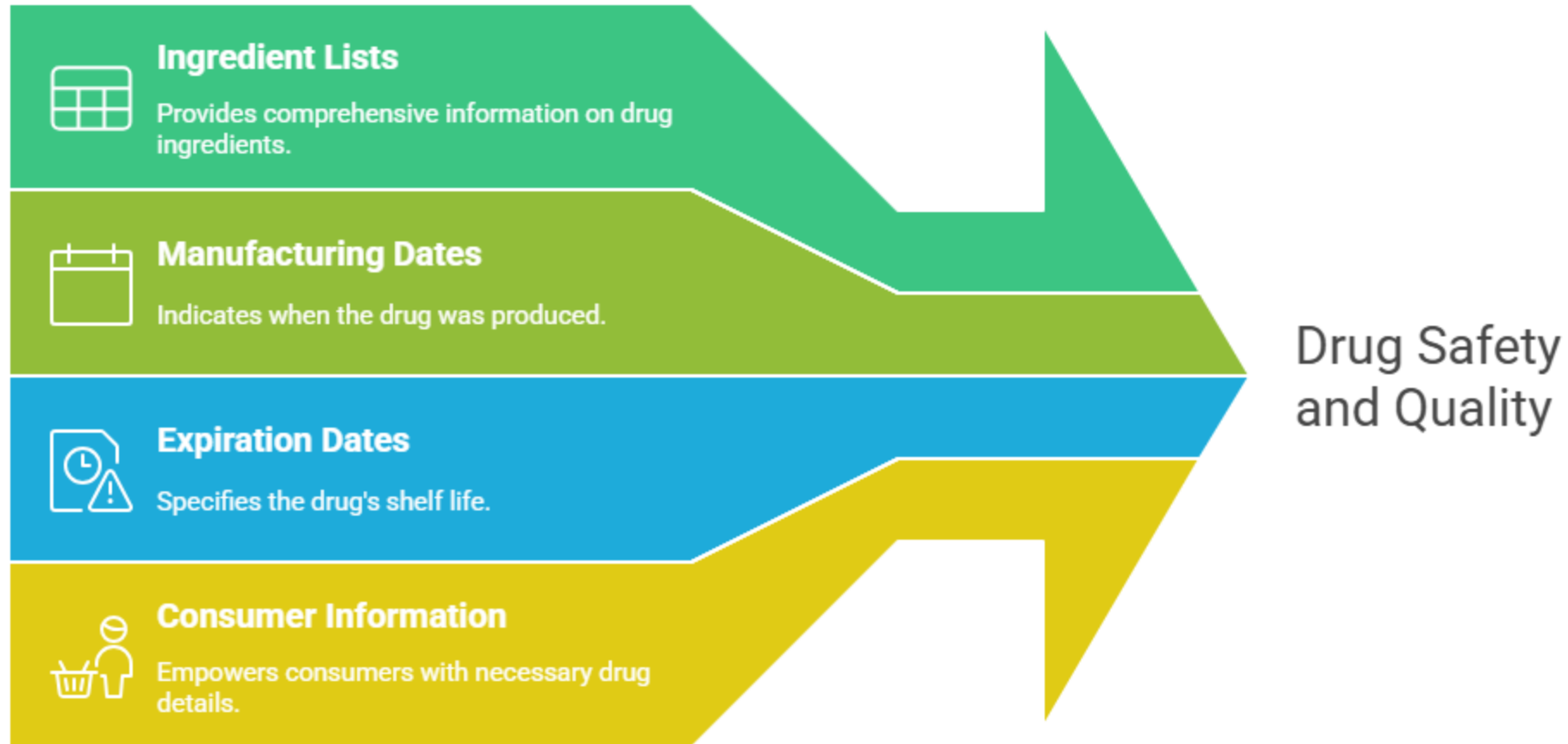


Adulterated

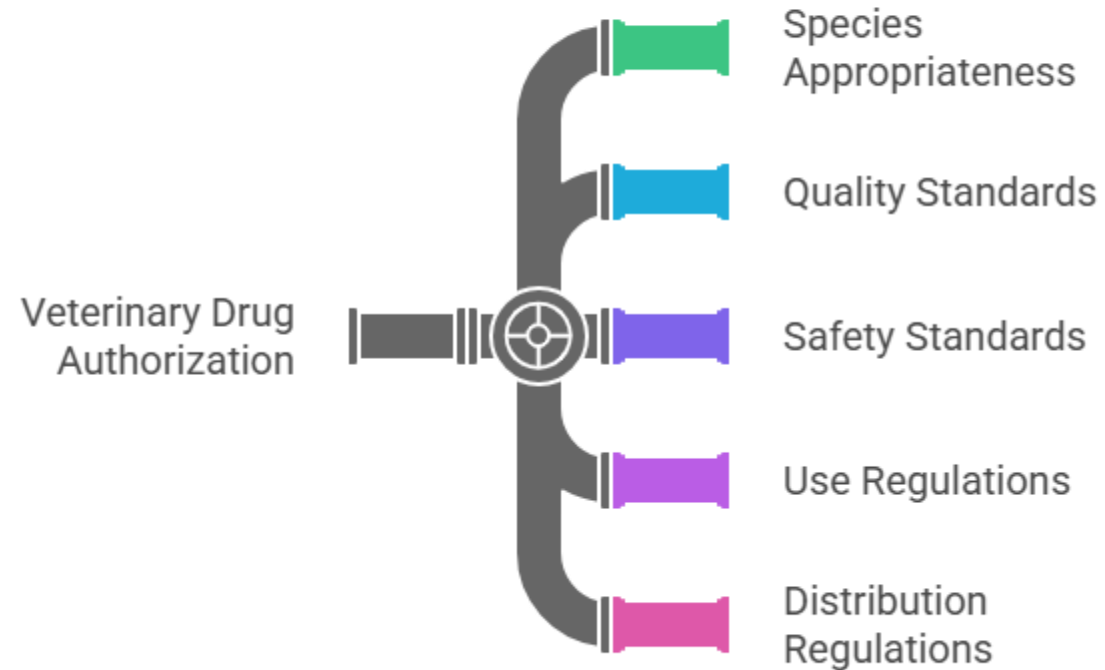
The product is contaminated or impure, posing health risks.

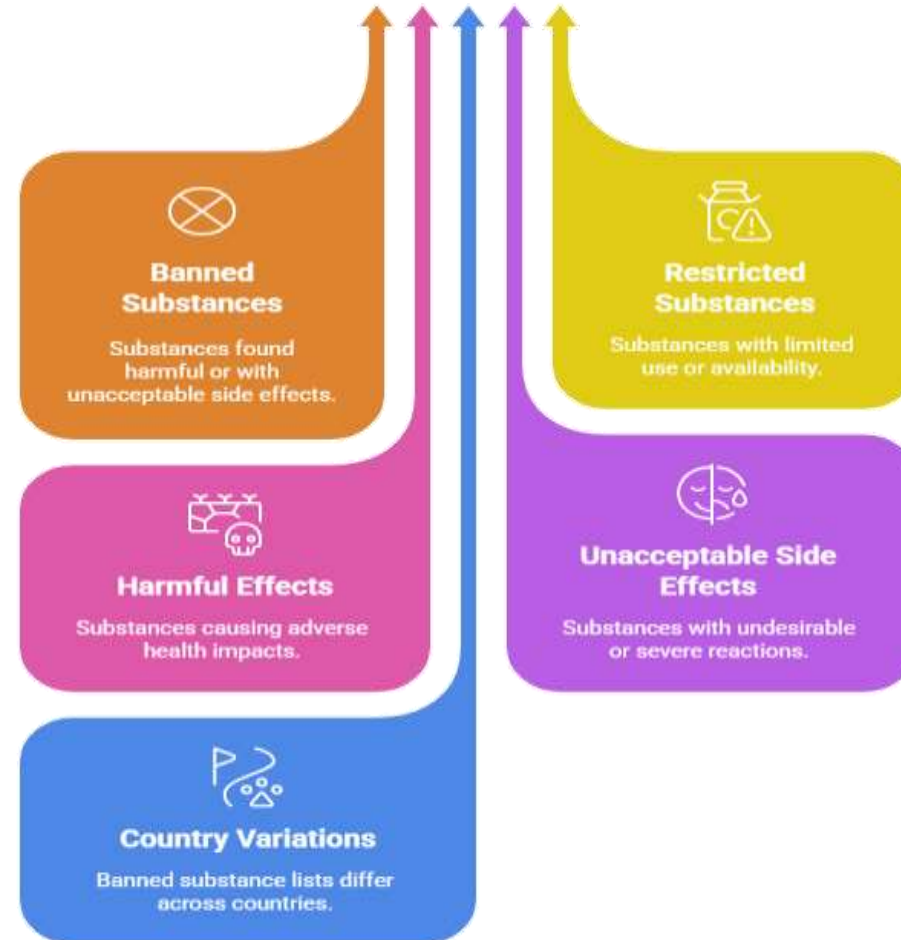
