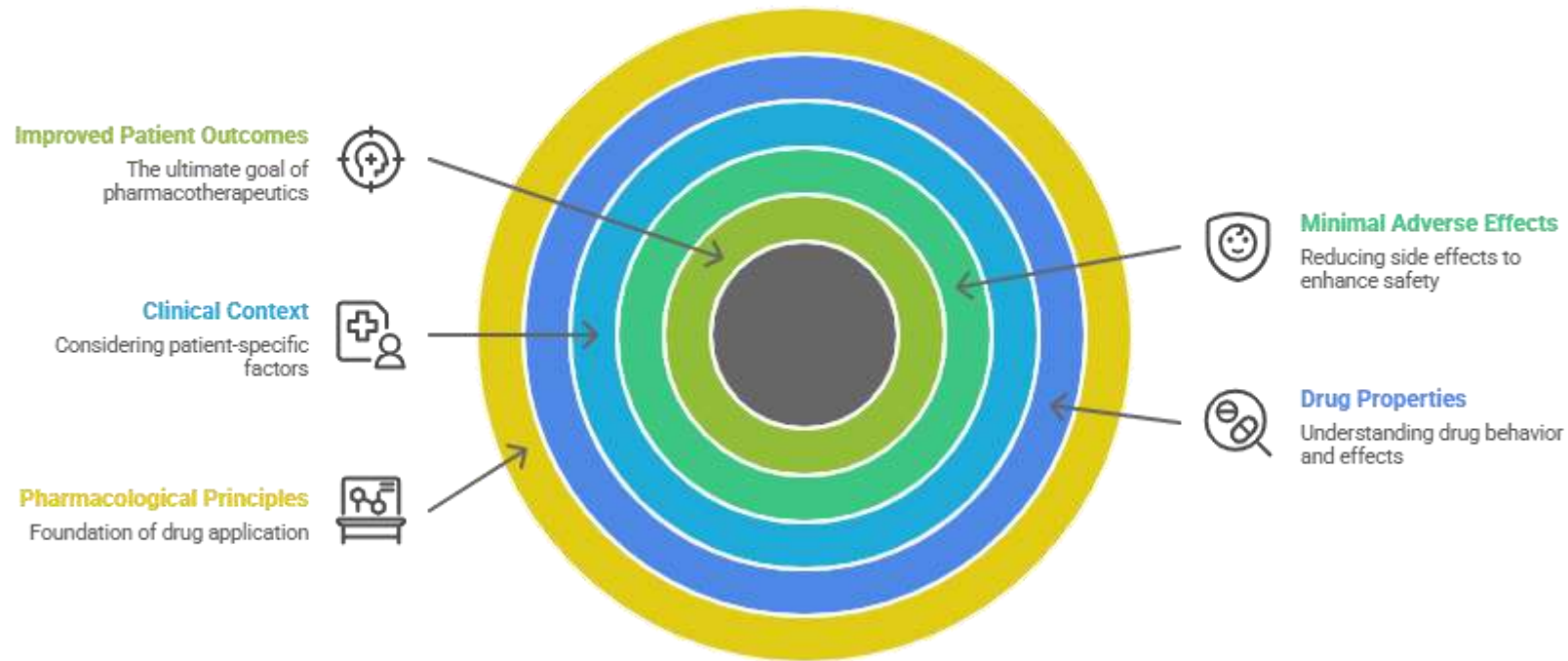

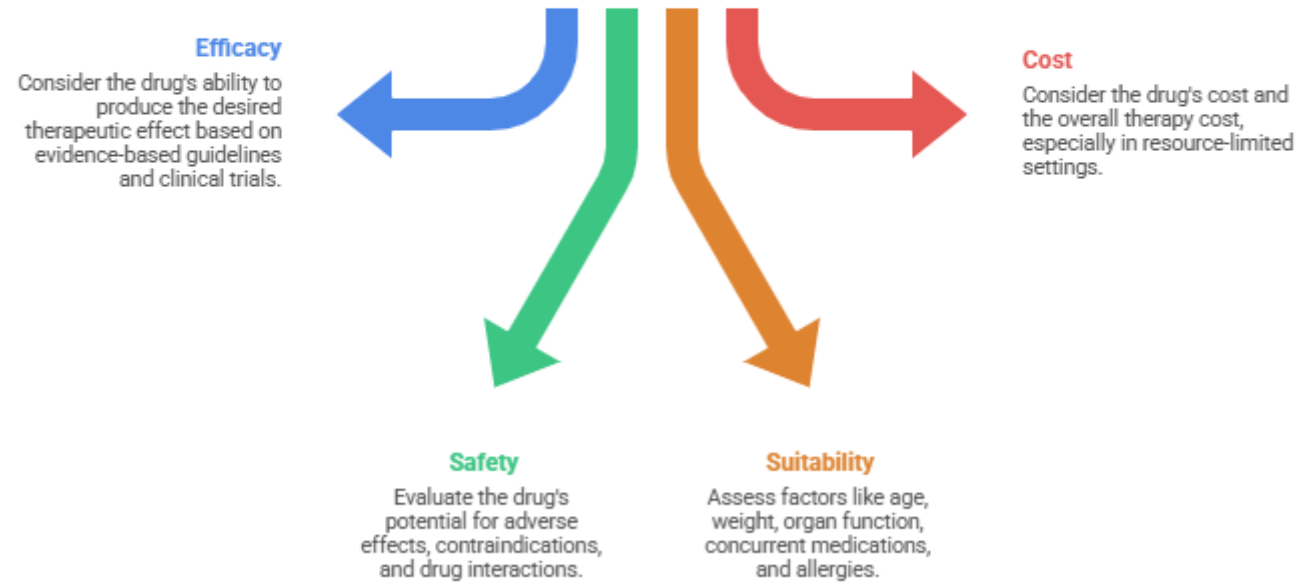


Pharmacotherapeutics Process



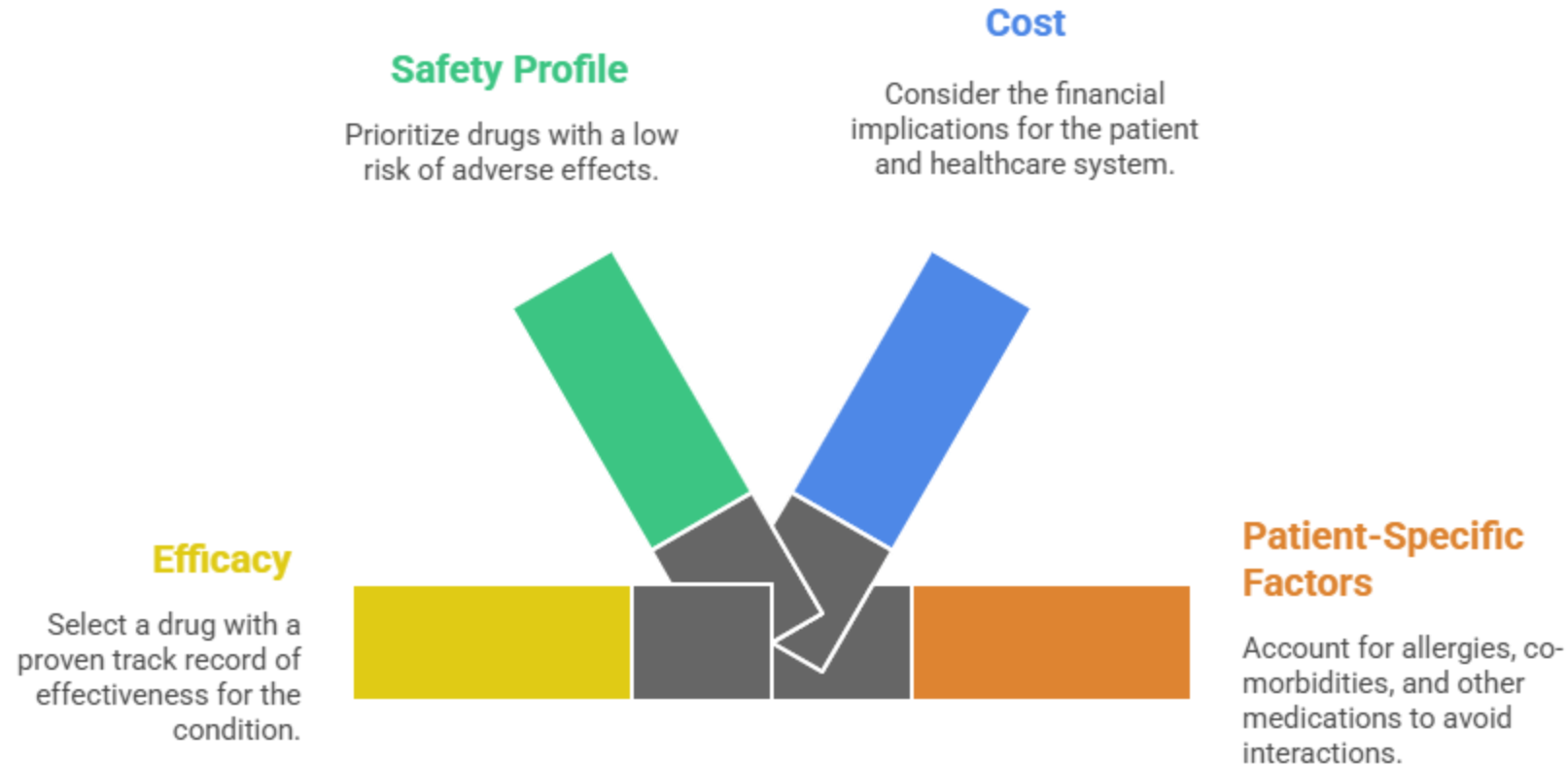
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Which drug should be selected for a patient?

Renal and Hepatic Function

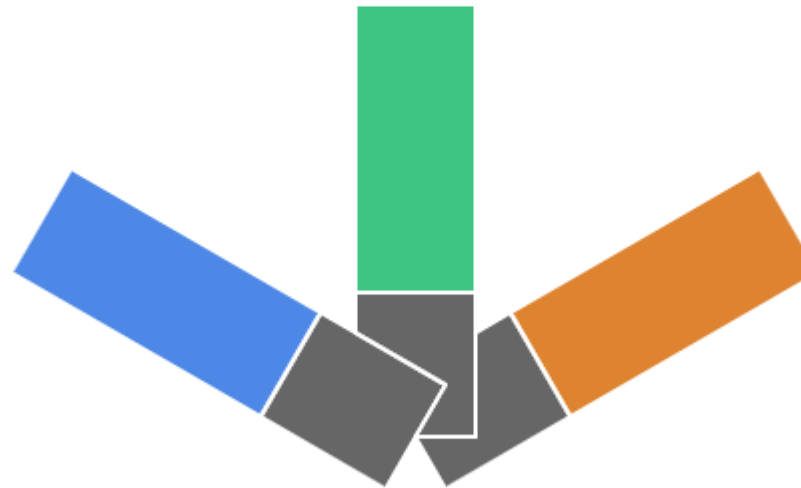
Modify dosage based on kidney and liver function to prevent drug accumulation.

Age and Weight

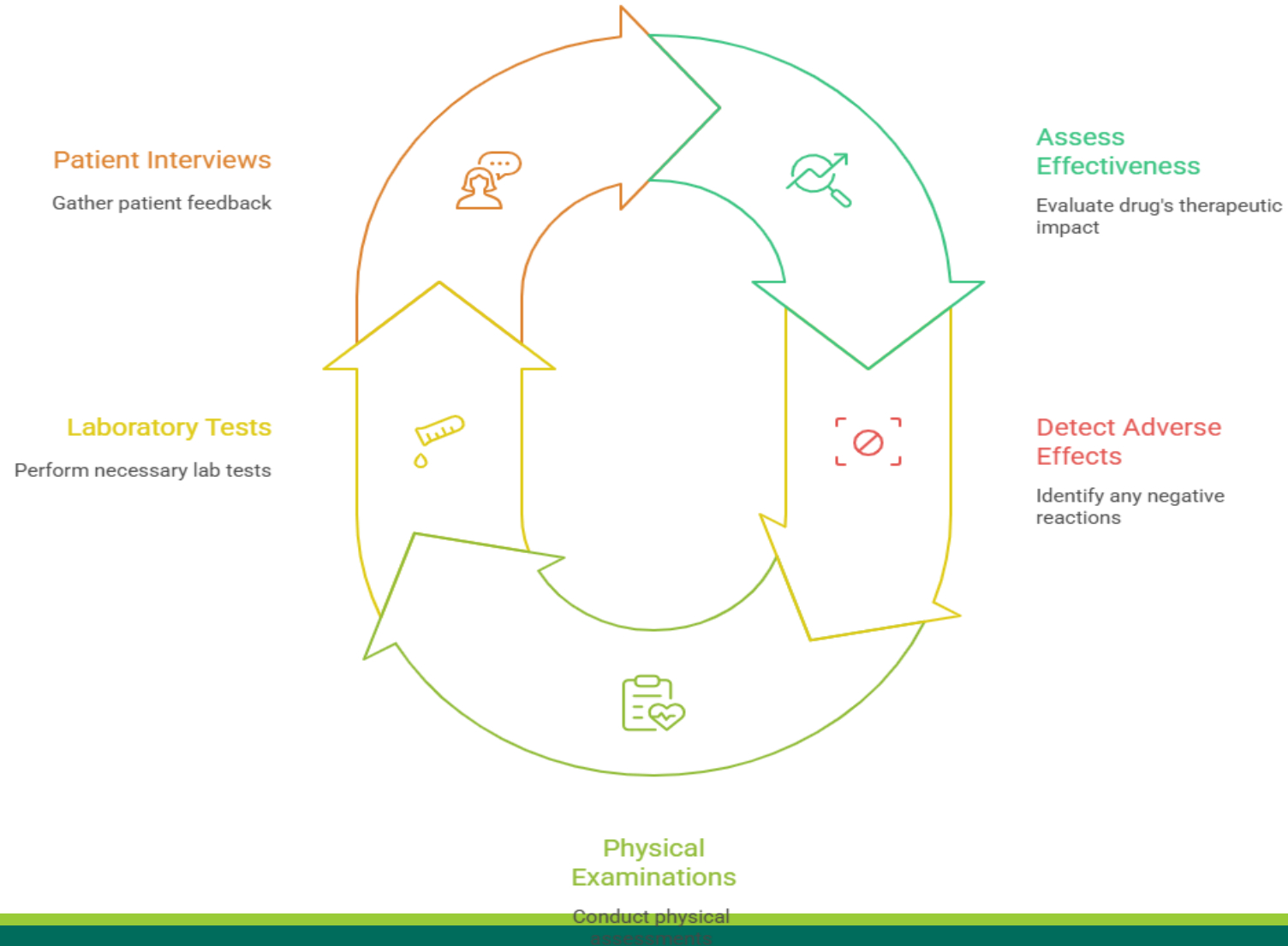
Adjust dosage based on patient's age and weight to ensure appropriate metabolism and elimination.

Route of Administration

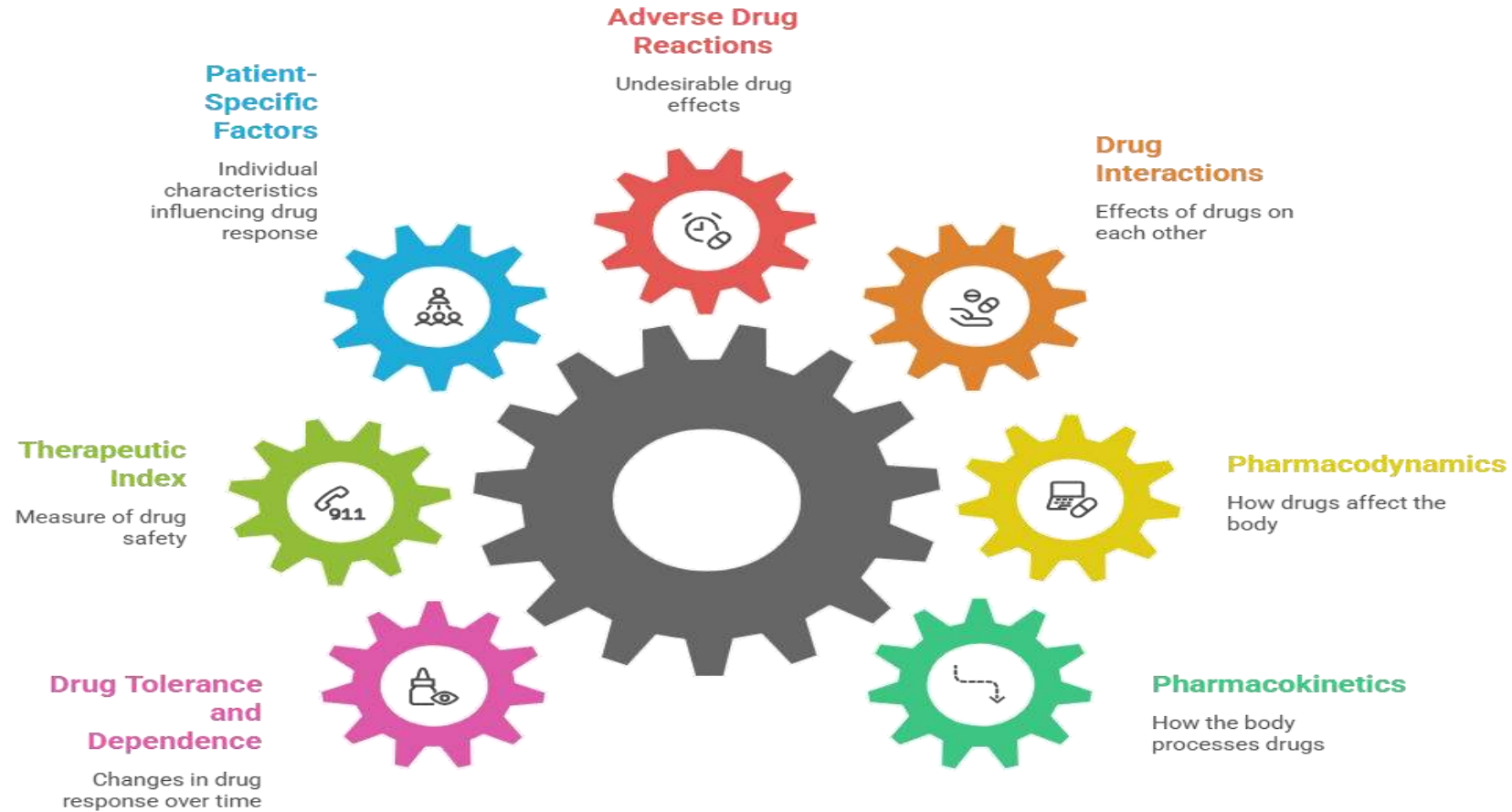
Select the most effective route (e.g., oral, intravenous) based on the drug's properties and patient's condition.
