## DESIGN THINKING STAGES IN CLASSIFICATION


**Empathize:** Understand the users — in this case, students, pharmacists, or researchers who use the alphabetical classification system.







## Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee Composition







# Unveiling Hospital Committee Roles


## Infection Control Committee

Evaluates and approves medications for hospital use.




## Hospital Formulary

# Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC)

- The HICC is an integral component of the **IPC programme**
- It is responsible for establishing and maintaining the IPC programme and its various functions
  - Monitoring, Surveillance, Reporting, Research and Education.
- The HICC should have wide representation from all relevant disciplines or departments in the facility.



## Responsibilities of the HICC

### 1. Establish the IPC Programme

- Develop an action plan for IPC measures.



- Constitute an infection control team



- Constitute an infection control team



- Review and revise annually infection control guidelines & policies.



- Organize training programmes for staff and other HCWs.



- Develop an antibiotic policy and antibiotic stewardship programme.



- Conduct surveillance of AMR and HAI.

# HOSPITAL FORMULARY

## 1 Formulary

**Formulary** is a list of medicines. Traditionally, a formulary contained a collection of formulas for the compounding and testing of medication.



## 2 Continuously Revised Compilation

The **hospital formulary** is a continuously revised compilation of pharmaceuticals which reflects the current clinical judgment of the medical staff.



## 3 Hospital Formulary System

The **hospital formulary system** is a method whereby the medical staff of a hospital, working through a **pharmacy and therapeutic** committee, evaluates, appraises and selects from among numerous available medicinal agents and dosage form those that are considered most useful in-patient care.





# GUIDELINE FOR HOSPITAL FORMULARY






**1 Appoint PTC**

The governing body of the hospital should appoint a pharmacy and therapeutic committee composed of physician and pharmacist which will prepare the hospital formulary system.

**2 Outline Purpose & Function**


PTC shall sponsor and outline the purpose, organization function and scope of the hospital formulary system, it should adopt the principle as per the need of particular hospital.

**3 Develop Policies & Procedures**

PTC develop policies and procedures - medical staff adopt these - subject to administrative approval


The policy and procedures shall afford guidance in the appraisal, selection, procurement, storage, distribution, use, safety procedures and other matter relating to drug in the hospital
