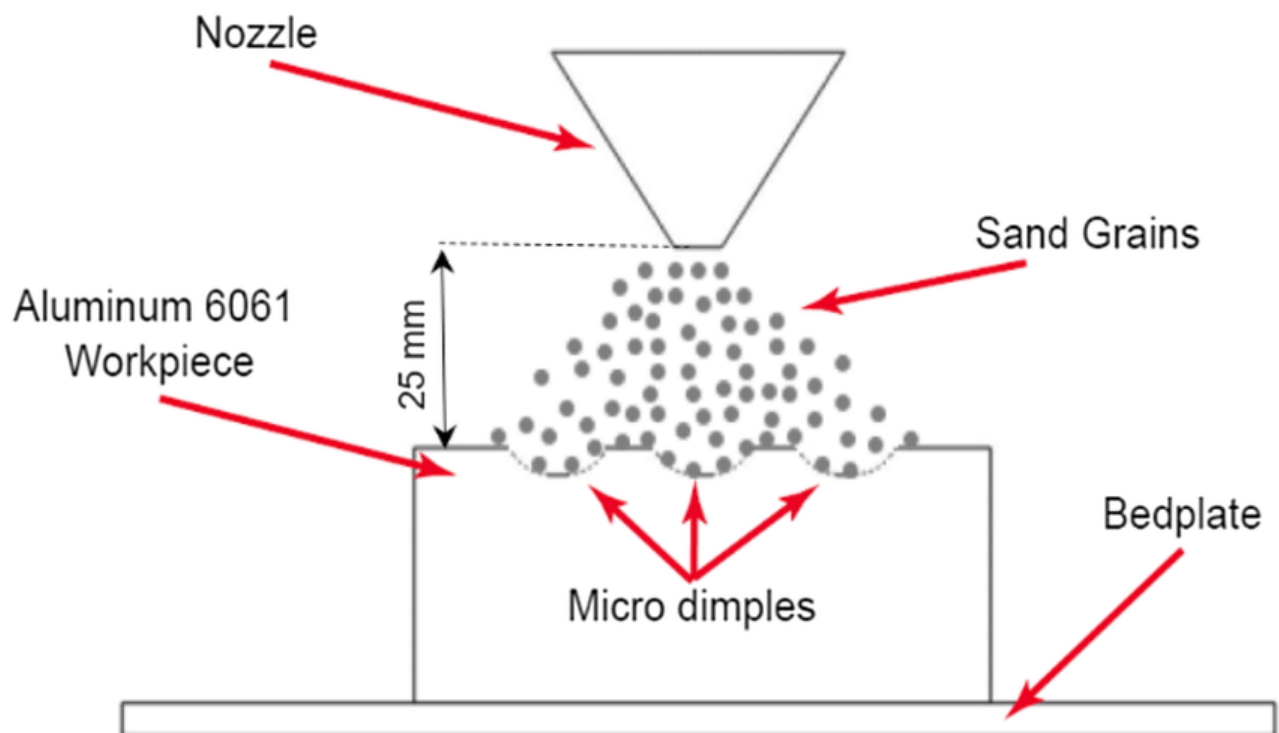


# Shot blasting
