



#### ARTICLES



Article is a word used to define whether a noun is mentioned in **specific** or in **general.** Those words are 'A', 'An', and 'The'. These words are divided into groups like,

- 1. **Definite Article**
- 2. Indefinite Article

### 1) **DEFINITE ARTICLE**

Definite Article is used to refer a specific or particular thing. Here definite article is word **'The'**.

**Example:** The car was stolen

This denotes a particular car.

- Let's go to the mall.
- Where is the house?
- The movie was amazing.

### **Rules for using 'The' :**

- 1. 'The' is used to mention a whole **group** or **class.**
- Eg: The Lion is a type of Carnivore
- The United States is a strong country in the world.
- The USA, The UAE, The UK
- The Elephant is the largest land mammal.





- 2. Used to particularize an **uncountable nouns.**
- **Eg:** The water in the Ocean is saline in nature.
- The furniture is neat and clean

#### 3. Used to mention Universal truth.

- Eg: The Sun rises in the east
- The Nile is the largest river in the world.
- 4. Used to the names of Oceans, Seas, rivers.
- Eg: The Pacific ocean, The river Ganga, The Arabian Sea.
- 5. Used to refer a group of island, mountain rages
- Eg: The Andamans is the most beautiful island.
- The Himalayas is located in India.

### 2) **INDEFINITE ARTICLE**

Indefinite Article is used to refer a non-specific or general thing. There are 2 indefinite articles like, 'A' and 'An'

- 'An' is used for words with vowel sound (a,e,i,o,u)
  Eg: An Apple, An elephant, An Umbrella.
- 'An' is used for words starting with silent 'h'
  Eg: An Hourglass, An honorable man
- **'An'** is used for **abbreviations Eg:** An M.B.B.S, An M.L.A
- **'An'** is used to mention **someone** who belongs to a **certain group Eg:** She is an Engineer





#### $\checkmark$ 'A' is used for words with consonant sound

- Eg: A Dog, A Car, A Pen, A shoe
- ✓ **EXCEPTION:** If a word begins with **vowel** and ends in **consonant** sound, use 'A'

**Eg:** A University (Here 'U' is vowel but the word produce sound 'T' ) A Union

#### **DON'T USE ARTICLES BEFORE :**

- 1. Proper noun like name of the people, place, thing
- 2. Nationalities She is French
- 3. Name of Country India is my country
- 4. Things sugar is bad for your health, Children like chocolates
- 5. Days, months, subject, festivals, seasons, language, material like gold, silver and diamond
